

The Final Cry

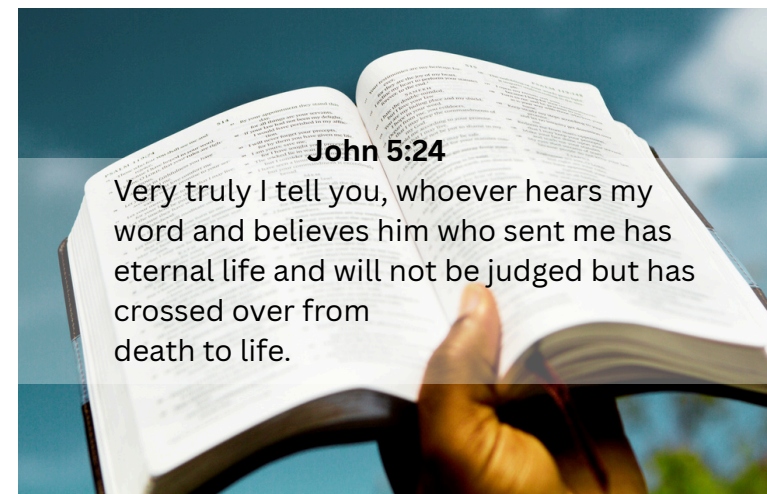
The Blueprint Written in Advance
