How to Realign Your Life Today

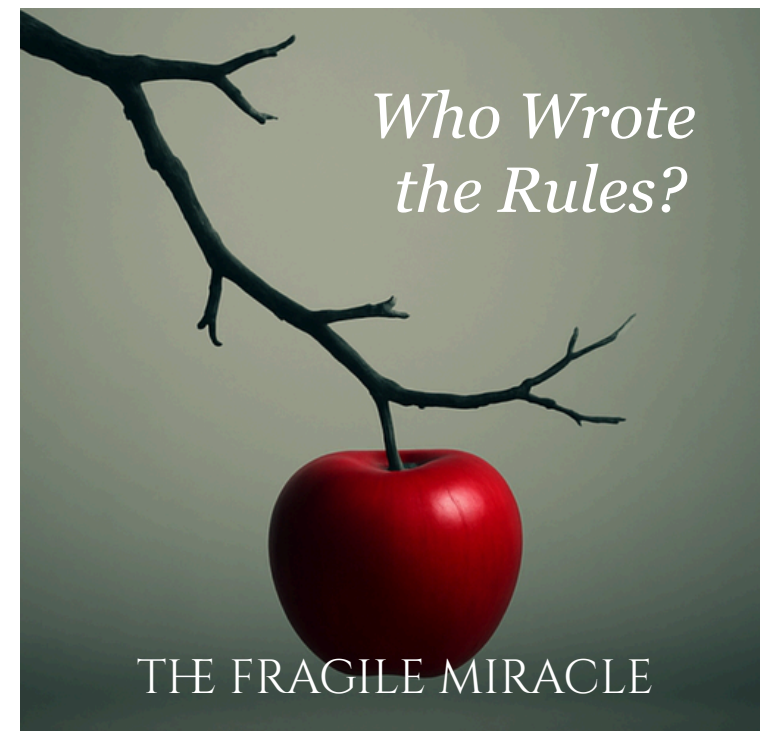
Ultimate alignment is the reconciliation of your thoughts, actions, and existence with eternal truth.
